HAZARD CLASSIFICATIONS: 6.1D, 6.3B, 6.4A, 6.8B, 9.3B

WARNING: Harmful if swallowed. Causes mild skin irritation. Causes serious eye irritation.

DANGER: May damage fertility or the unborn child. Toxic to terrestrial vertebrates.

COMPONENTS: 125 g/L Calcium, 105 g/L Nitrogen, 15 g/L Magnesium, 0.76g/L Boron (4.3g/L Boric Acid), 0.6g/L Zinc (4.5g/L Zinc EDTA), 1.2g/L Iron (9.1g/L Iron EDTA), 0.6g/L Manganese (4.5g/L Manganese EDTA), 0.6g/L Copper (4.0g/L Copper EDTA). Also contains a penetrating non-ionic surfactant for improving uptake.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Apples require high levels of calcium to minimise storage disorders, especially bitter pit. A season long regular foliar application of calcium sprays, beginning and finishing with Calcium 175™ has proven to be most effective. Calcium 175, a calcium chloride based product, should be the growers' product of choice. However, some growers have a need for early nitrogen and additional micronutrients and in this case Encal should be used.

Encal may be applied with most herbicides, insecticides, fungicides or nutrient sprays. It is compatible with most chemicals, but for unknown or doubtful chemicals a test mix should be made up. Generally, Encal should be added before most chemicals, except where a product data sheet specifies otherwise i.e. cupric hydroxide. Always apply diluted or mixed chemicals immediately, do not store.

RATES AND TIMING: Encal should be applied in low light conditions in the morning, evening or on cloudy days. Do not apply during periods of high sunlight, during rain or prior to expected rain. Avoid spraying under fast or slow drying conditions.

WATER RATE: For orchard use, use at least 500L/ha. Dilute spray application is best. Calculate spray volume so that actual water rate is just to run-off.

CROP	RATE & TIMING
Pipfruit seasonal useage	Use a minimum of 100L spread throughout the season. For varieties prone to calcium disorders, ensure that at least 150L of Encal or Calcium 175 is applied over the growing season. EARLY SEASON: Begin the week after petal fall and apply a total of 30L/ha over the next 30–35 days as 3–4 applications of 7.5–10L/ha at 7–10 day intervals. MID SEASON: Apply 7.5–12.5L/ha at 10–14 day intervals. LATE SEASON: Make 3 applications, each 10–12.5L/ha at 7 day intervals with the last application 7–10 days prior to harvest.
Kiwifruit	To improve fruit firmness, size and storage use 3–5L/ha. Apply at end of flowering, repeat 10–14 days later.
