Vehicle	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn traffic. Check for spills/leaks. Call emergency services.						
Spill	Wear PPE: goggles or face shield, overalls and chemical resistant gloves. Stop the source of spill if safe to do so. Clear area of unnecessary personnel. Spills may be slippery and should be cleaned up immediately. Contain the spill to prevent any further contamination of the soil, surface or ground water. Do not allow material to enter sewers or bodies of water. Large spills should be barricaded with inert material. Absorb with clay granules, sand or other absorbent material and sweep to a waste container. Dispose of safely in an approved landfill. Contact emergency services as required.						
Fire	Call Fire Service. Wear protective clothing including BA. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep unauthorised personnel away. Extinguish with foam, dry chemical powder or water spray. Contain run-off.						
First Aid Actions: If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/ physician if you feel unwell.							
If swallowed	Rinse mouth with water immediately. Do NOT induce vomiting. Seek medical advice.						
If in eye	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.						
If on skin	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove all contaminated clothing immediately. Wash clothing before re-use. If irritation occurs, get medical advice/attention.
