<b>Spill</b>	Isolate spillage area for at least 10m in all directions. Sweep carefully into appropriate container (drum) ensuring that entry into any waterways or drains is prevented. Wash down contaminated area with minimum amount of water, ensuring that entry into any waterways or drains is prevented. Dam and absorb washings using a suitable absorbent such as vermiculite and collect in suitable container (drum).					
<b>Fire</b>	Use CO2, foam or dry chemical. Do not use water jets as this will spread the fire.					
<b>First Aid Actions: If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.</b>						
<b>If swallowed</b>	Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting.
